Colleagues,

As we all adjust to the “new normal” with our plans in response to COVID-19 to ensure we are doing all that we can to further protect each other, our EMS community, our employees, patients and families, we have an additional ask of our EMS partners.

We ask, effective today, that all EMS providers don a surgical mask and gloves when entering and functioning within our AHN facilities. This includes both emergency & non-emergency crews. We also want to reinforce that all patients should have a surgical mask applied and in place before entering or departing a facility.

All AHN Emergency Departments will replace 1:1 any EMS utilized surgical mask. The chart below will identify each facility and the specific location for resupply at that facility.

As we continue to adapt to this ever-changing environment, we truly appreciate all of your efforts towards combating this pandemic.
